The Enterprise Version supports user authentication and the creation of multiple user accounts within an organization. Individual user activity and training progress can be tracked through a centralized management system.

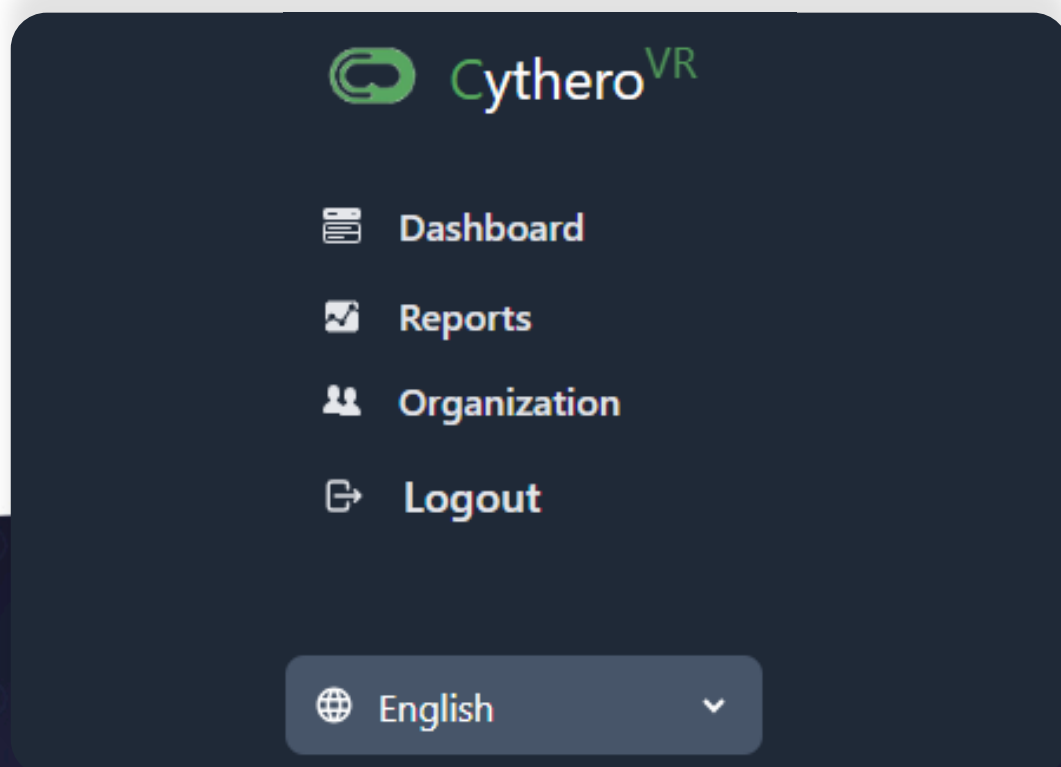
A web-based administration panel is included for managing user accounts, configuring organization settings, license management, and reviewing trainee performance data. The administration panel also provides reporting functionality, enabling the generation of detailed training and usage reports.

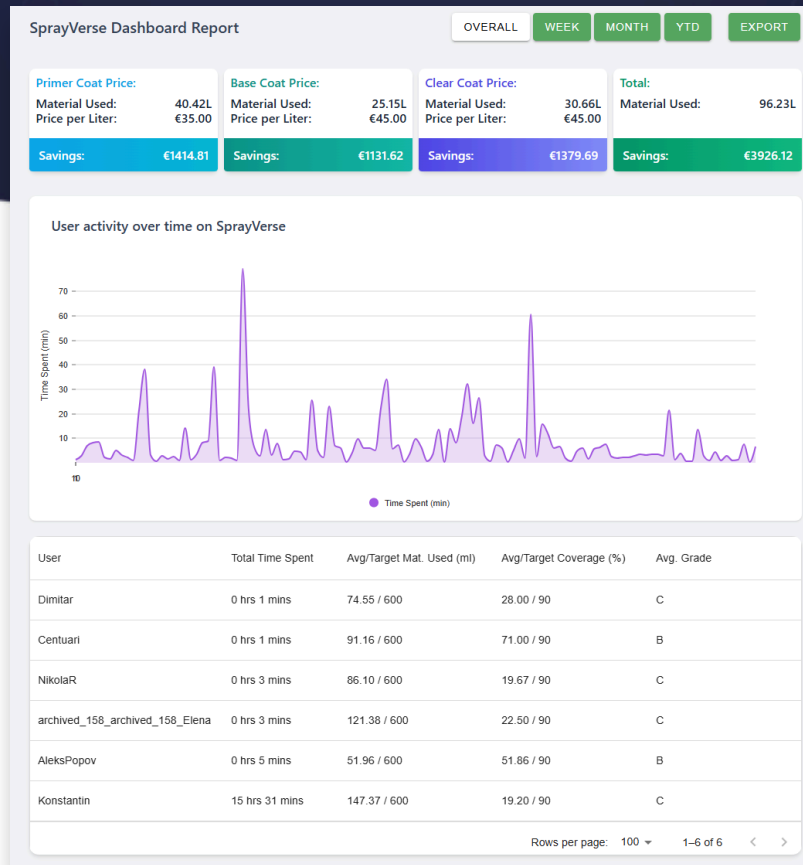
Navigation

The navigation panel, located on the left side of the interface, provides access to the platform's primary functions:

- **Dashboard** – Displays key metrics, statistics, and system information.
- **Reports** – Provides access to available reports and reporting tools.
- **Organization** – Allows management of organization-specific settings and configuration options.
- **Logout** – Signs the current user out of the platform.

The interface also includes a language selection option, allowing users to change the display language of the platform.





Dashboard

Each SprayVerse All-in-One package includes a 5-year subscription to the cloud-based web portal, providing access to analytics and reporting tools.

The dashboard provides data on material usage, cost distribution, and performance metrics across training sessions. It includes a Material Cost Analysis module that breaks down consumption and pricing for primer, base coat, and clear coat, along with calculated cost savings per session. Users can monitor Total Material Load, review cost efficiency, and track cumulative savings over time.

A User Activity Chart displays session-based trends, including spray gun usage and performance changes across time. A Performance Metrics table summarizes key values such as total training time, material waste load, paint focus consistency, and average scoring.

Time filters (Weekly, Monthly, Yearly, Custom) allow users to adjust the reporting range. The system is designed to support analysis of training data and review of operational efficiency metrics.

Reports

The SprayVerse Reports interface is designed to provide users with comprehensive and actionable insights through tailored reports. It features three key report types:

- **Trainee Performance Report**
- **Part Report**
- **Training Sessions**

These reports streamline performance tracking and ensure users meet their training goals effectively.

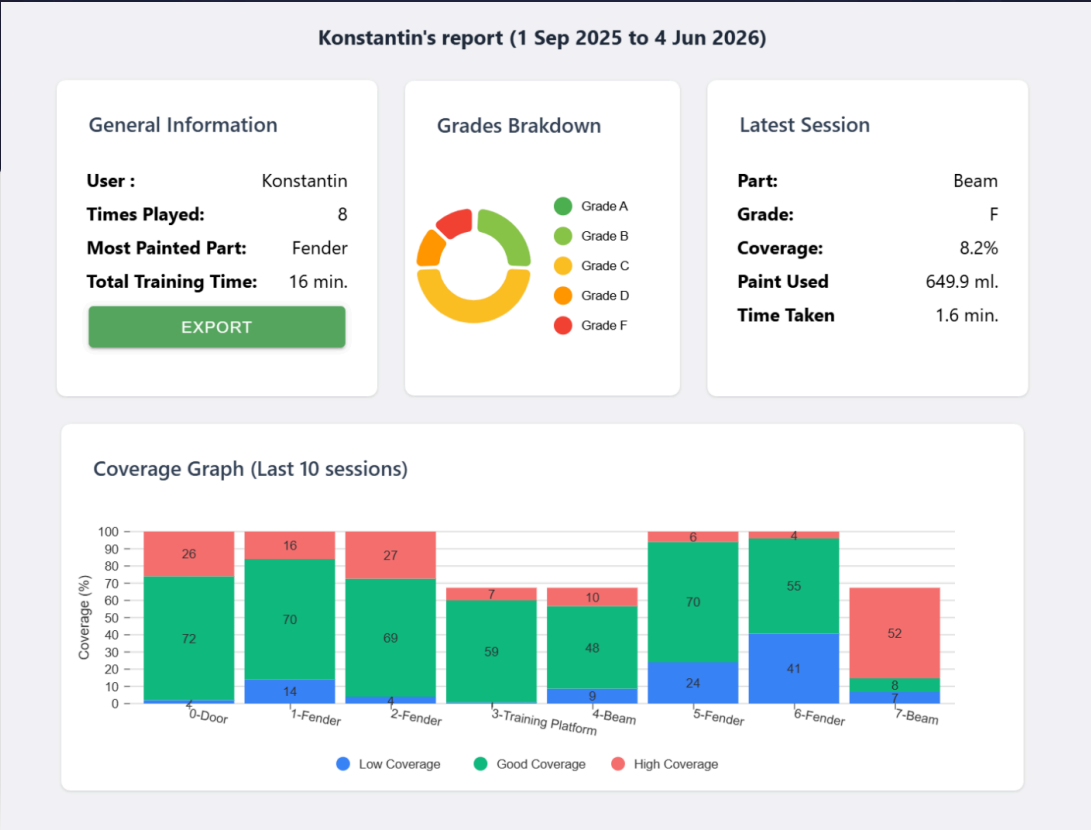

Trainee Performance Report

The Trainee Performance Report provides a consolidated overview of user progress over a selected time period, delivering insights into performance, activity levels, and skill development trends. It aggregates key training data into a structured summary to support both individual evaluation and long-term improvement tracking.

The report includes a general information overview, a detailed breakdown of performance grades, and a summary of the most recent training session. It also features a coverage graph that visualizes performance trends across multiple sessions, enabling clear identification of consistency, progression, and variability over time.

Designed as both a visual and analytical assessment tool, the report supports the evaluation of user engagement, technical proficiency, and key areas for targeted improvement within the SprayVerse training system.

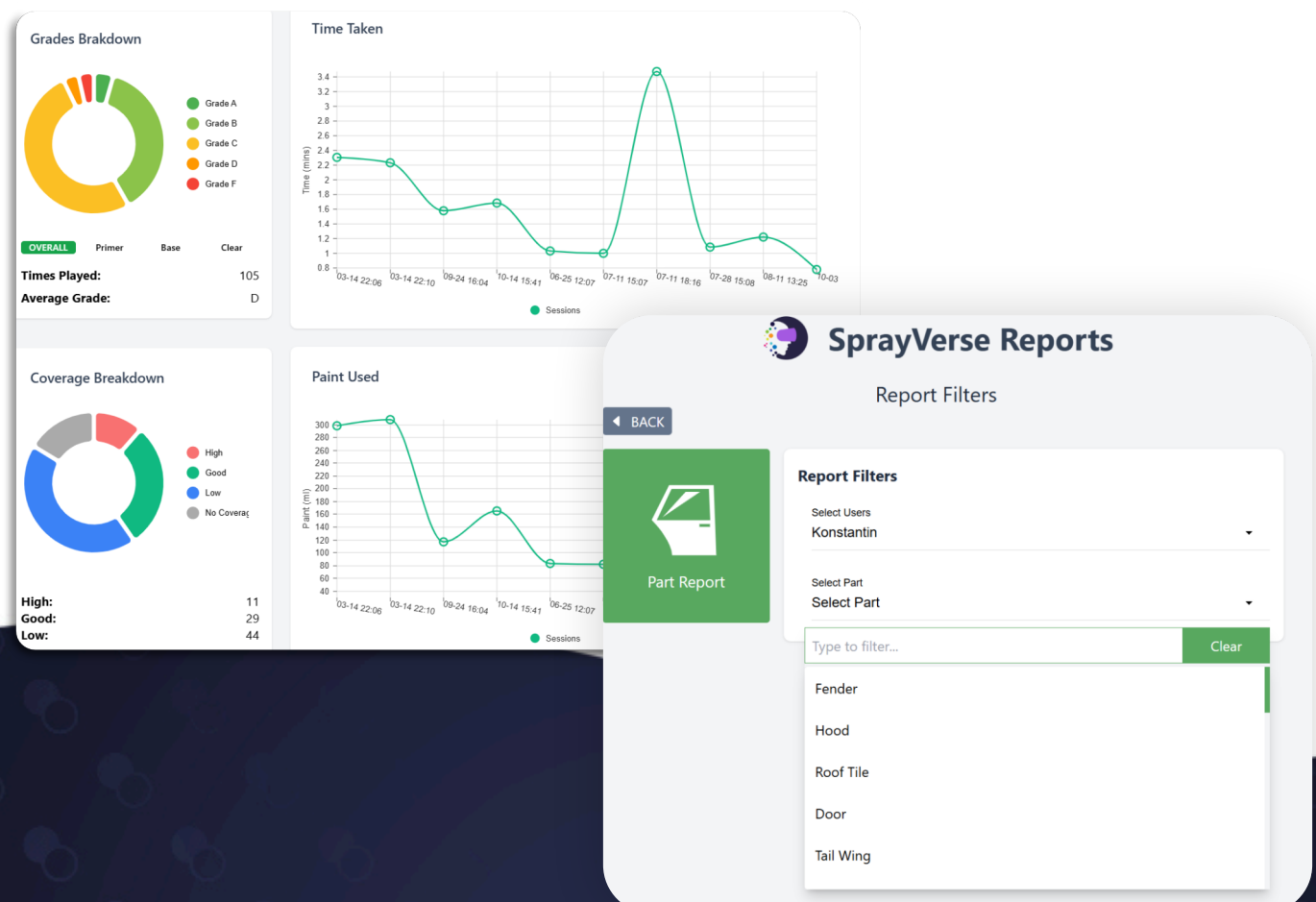
Part Report

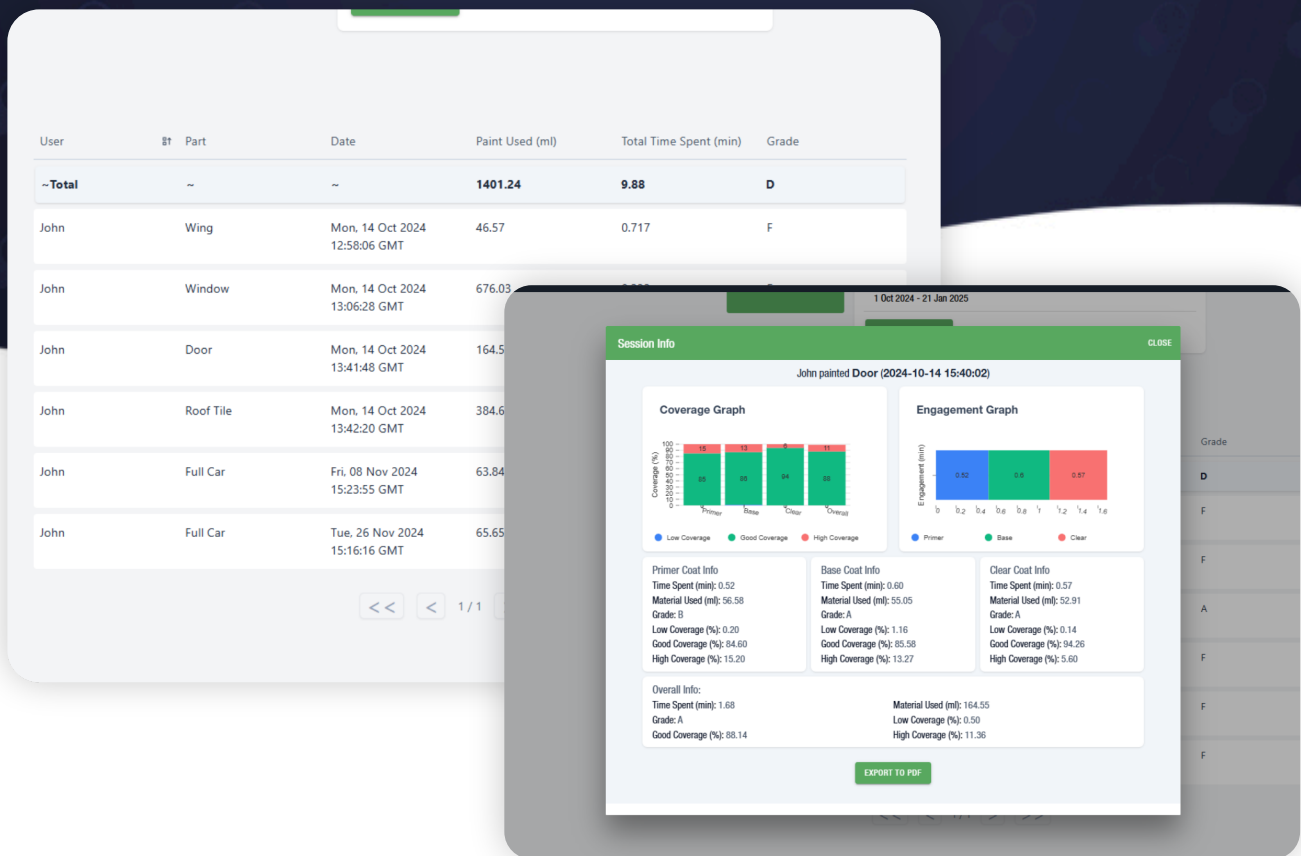
The Part Report in SprayVerse is a data view focused on analyzing performance metrics tied to a specific part across multiple sessions.

It includes a grade breakdown chart that shows how performance scores are distributed across sessions or evaluation criteria. A coverage breakdown section presents paint application data, indicating how consistently and uniformly the surface has been covered.

Line graphs are used to track changes over time, including total time spent per session and the amount of paint used. These allow comparison of efficiency and resource consumption between attempts.

The report also includes numerical summaries such as average grades and total/average material usage. Together, these elements provide a structured dataset for reviewing consistency, identifying deviations between sessions, and comparing performance metrics over time without requiring manual calculation.





Training Sessions

The Training Session Report provides a comprehensive record of all completed user sessions, offering both high-level summaries and in-depth analytical insights for each individual training activity.

The session overview presents key data points including the trained part, session date, total paint consumption, total time spent, and achieved grade, delivering a clear and structured snapshot of overall performance across all sessions.

Each entry can be expanded to reveal detailed analytics such as Coverage Graphs and Engagement Graphs, which assess both the quality of paint application and the level of user interaction throughout the training process. Additional session-specific metrics include primer coat data, time allocation per layer, material usage breakdowns, and coverage percentages.

An overall performance assessment consolidates these metrics into a unified summary of time efficiency, grading outcomes, and application quality. This level of detailed breakdown enables users to systematically track progress, identify behavioral and technical patterns, and continuously refine their spray techniques for improved performance outcomes.

Usage Report

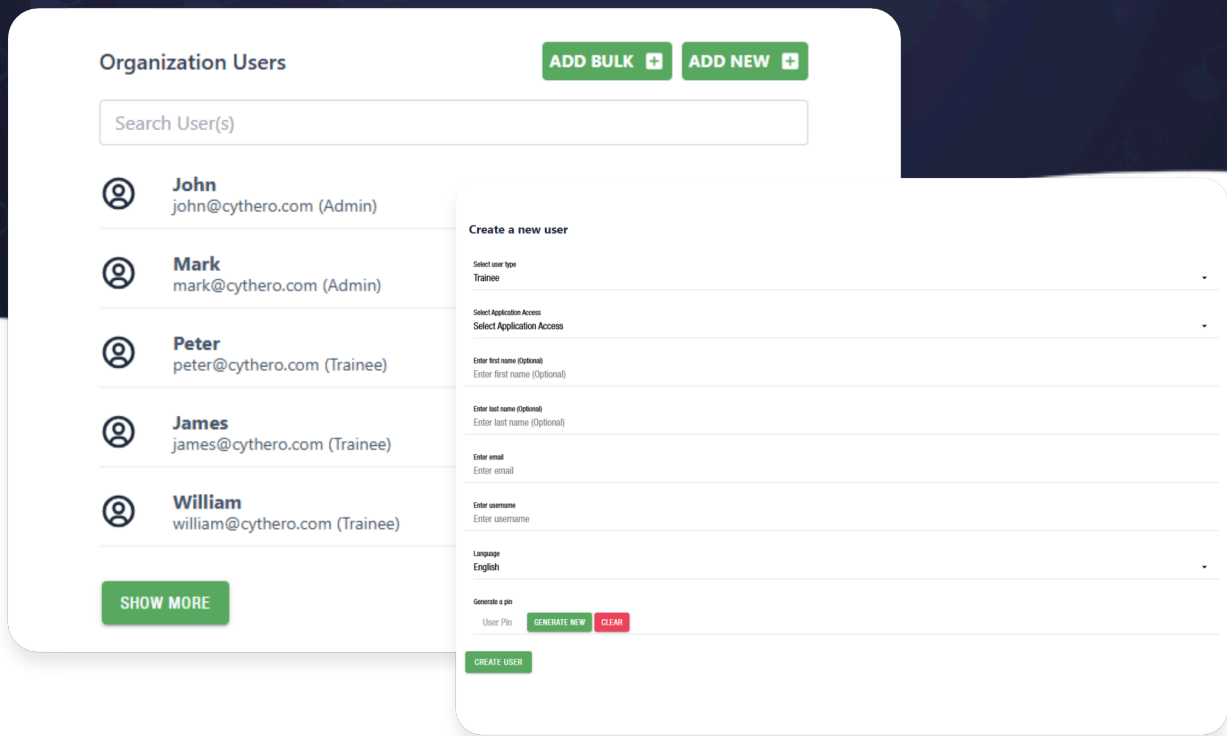
The Usage Report is contained within the Training Session's Session Info view. It presents per-session data in a list format, including the part used, session date, total paint consumption, total time spent, and achieved grade, allowing for quick comparison across sessions.

Each session entry can be expanded to access additional analytics. This includes a Coverage Graph, which visualizes paint distribution across the surface, and an Engagement Graph, which shows user interaction patterns during the session.

Session-level details include primer coat data, time distribution per layer, total material usage, and coverage percentages. An aggregated summary is also available, combining total time, grades, and coverage quality into a single consolidated view.

The structure is designed to support review of consistency across training sessions, identification of usage patterns, and comparison of performance metrics over time within the Training Session environment.





User Management

The User Management interface provides administrative control over user accounts within the system.

It includes a search and filter function that allows users to be located by name or email address. New accounts can be created individually through an Add New option, where required user details are entered.

For larger setups, bulk user creation is supported through a CSV upload via the Add Bulk function, enabling multiple accounts to be added in a single operation.

Existing users can be edited or removed through a contextual menu associated with each user entry. This includes updating user information and adjusting access settings.

Role assignment is available for each user, allowing roles such as Admin, Trainee, or Trainer to be defined in order to control permissions and system access.

When creating or editing accounts, the system generates or requires a PIN and username, which are used as login credentials for accessing the application.

Branding

To modify branding profiles, go to the Organization module and open the SprayVerse Application section.

Within this area, access the Branding Profiles module. From there, select an existing profile to edit its configuration.

This section is used to manage application-level branding settings so that the interface and associated assets remain aligned with the organization's defined visual identity.

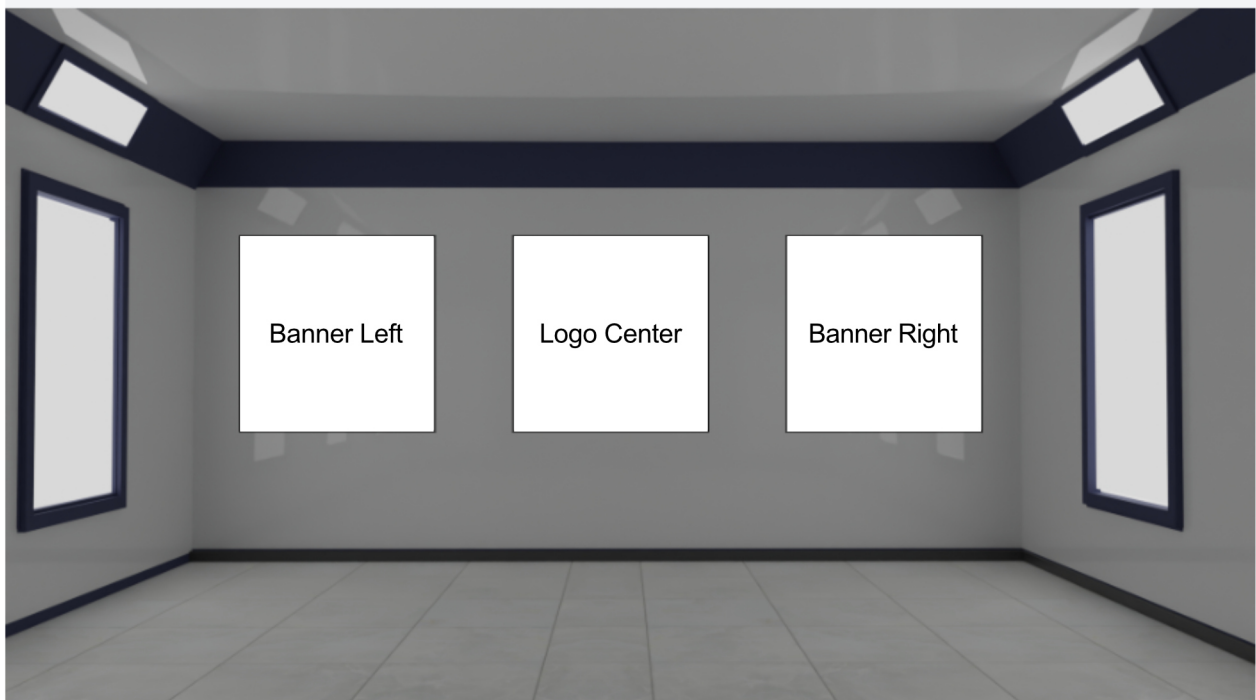

ROI Calculations

The ROI Calculations settings screen is used to configure the input values and assumptions that support return on investment (ROI) calculations within the system.

It allows adjustment of material cost parameters, including clear coat, base coat, and primer coat pricing. It also defines operational targets such as weekly paint time, expected material usage per session, and target coverage percentages.

A currency setting is included to define the symbol used throughout ROI outputs, ensuring consistency with regional or organizational standards.

These settings act as the baseline inputs for all ROI-related computations and reporting, directly affecting how cost efficiency, material consumption, and performance efficiency are calculated and displayed.
